

Used Car Seats

The following information can help you figure out when a used car seat is **NOT** safe to use. If you are not sure about the answer to any of the questions, it is best not to use the seat.

Does the seat have a label with the model name, model number, and manufacture date?*	
Yes	No Do not use
Has the seat been involved in a crash?	
Yes Do not use	No
Is the seat expired?	
Yes Do not use	No
Does the seat show signs of damage (cracks, tears, rust, fraying)?	
Yes Do not use	No
Does the seat have missing or broken parts?	
Yes STOP Do not use	No
*Needed for expiration date and to loo	k up recall information

Before using any car seat, you should contact the manufacturer to register it and confirm it is not recalled. If needed, the manufacturer will also be able to provide the car seat's instruction manual.
